



- 10mm Pilkington **Pyrodur**TM
- Mild steel framework
- Mild steel glazing beads on exposed face
- Glass bedded using ceramic fibre tape




- 10mm Pilkington **Pyrodur**™

 Pane A UV filter on unexposed face

 Pane B UV filter on exposed face
- 2 5mm hardwood setting block
- $70 \times 50 \times 2$ mm mild steel tubular frame section, with 20mm wide lip
- $90 \times 50 \times 2$ mm mild steel tubular section, with 20mm wide flanges
- 5 $20 \times 20 \times 1.25$ mm mild steel glazing beads
- FISCHER countersunk head anchor bolt fixings at nominal 600mm centres head/base, 400mm vertically
- 7 ROCKWOOL LTD. mineral fibre insulation packing
- 8 15 × 3mm CARBORUNDUM RESISTANT MATERIALS LTD. Fibrefax glazing tape
